Policies and procedures of specific journals in regard to the NIH Public Access Policy. If a journal is listed here, it HAS AGREED to comply with the Policy (though there may be stipulations, sometimes significant, which will be shown).

Three ways to comply with the "submission" component of the NIH Public Access Policy:

Journal will do everything, and will submit the article as published. Author needs only to reference PMID of applicable articles in reports etc. to NIH.

Journal will submit final manuscript for you, but you must provide grant information, as well as review and approve the new PMC version.

Journal won't do anything; You must submit the final manuscript, affirm copyright agreement, provide the grant information, and review and approve the new PMC version.
